Every Sunday from September through May, youth across the stake meet for Mission Prep — learning to teach the gospel the way full-time missionaries do. Teaching is a skill, and a skill needs somewhere real to practice. That is what your home gives them.

What a visit looks like

- ✓ A short gospel lesson in your living room — about 30 to 45 minutes.
- ✓ Taught the way a full-time missionary would teach it.
- ✓ At a time you agree beforehand.
- ✓ You listen. That is your whole part.

It goes both ways.

For the youth

- ✓ A real family to teach, not a practice partner.
- ✓ Confidence before they ever enter the mission field.
- ✓ Someone who listens while they find their voice.

For your family

- ✓ The gospel taught in your own living room.
- ✓ Your children watching a peer prepare to serve.
- ✓ A quiet part in the beginning of a missionary.

EVERY VISIT

Youth always come in companionships of two or more and teach on their own · Both husband and wife must be present for them to enter a home; if one of you cannot be there, a leader attends in your place · Your bishop approves your family before any visit is arranged
